

# Talisman Resort in Grey Highlands has been sold

The Talisman Resort in Grey Highlands is getting a new lease on life.

The resort closed in 2011 and was falling into disrepair. The Township of Grey Highlands took over the property after previous efforts to find a buyer failed. On Monday, they announced that a buyer has been found.

The new ownership group, which is headed by Brian Ellis, is promising to develop it into a hotel and spa resort with a convention centre. The group also says it will renovate the main lodge of the resort as well as rooms on the property.
